Clifton Career Development School

Clifton CDS provides centralized Career and Technical Education courses to high school students across Austin ISD, expanding the offerings for all campuses. Students complete a coherent sequence of courses over 2-3 years that incorporate classroom instruction, hands-on labs, and internships.

- Students take 6 out of 8 periods at their home campus and ride an AISD bus to/from Clifton for their selected program of study.
- Classes are double-blocked, which allows students to earn 2 credits at the end of each year.
- Students have the opportunity to earn industry certifications.
