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ARE YOU CONSIDERED COLLEGE READY?

If you plan on attending a public college or university in Texas, you must meet The Texas Success Initiative (TSI) standards in math, reading, and writing to avoid developmental courses in college. Developmental courses will cost you time and money, and will not count toward your degree credits. Students can reach college readiness standards by meeting or exceeding specific scores on **either** the SAT, ACT, or TSI Assessment. A combination of test results may also be used to show college readiness.

Scores needed for College Readiness

Test	College Ready Math Score Needed	College Ready Reading and Writing Scores Needed
SAT	530 or higher in Math	480 or higher in Reading and Writing
ACT	19 Math <u>AND</u> 23 composite score	19 English <u>AND</u> 23 composite score
TSI Assessment	Math 350	Reading 351 <u>AND</u> <u>New Writing are as follow:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 340 – 390 on TSI Writing Placement <u>and</u> minimum 4 on WritePlacer essay OR • 310 – 339 on TSI Writing Placement <u>and</u> levels 4-6 on ABE Diagnostic <u>and</u> minimum 5 on WritePlacer Essay

WILL THIS AFFECT MY OFF PERIODS?

- Seniors who are not considered college ready, will not be allowed to have any off periods until college ready scores are met.

HOW DO I SIGN UP FOR THE TSI TEST?

- Log onto your Naviance account and select TSI testing under links on your home page
- OR See Mrs. Mason in room 133.

WHERE DO I TAKE THE TSI TEST?

- Testing will occur in the College & Career Center, room 133 starting promptly at 9:00AM or 1:30PM. The test is untimed. For more details, contact Mrs. Mason in room 133.

Do I have to take all 3 parts of the exam? What are the passing standards?
