## ARE YOU CONSIDERED COLLEGE READY?

If you plan on attending a public college or university in Texas, you must meet <u>The Texas Success Initiative</u> (TSI) standards in math, reading, and writing to avoid developmental courses in college. Developmental courses will cost you time and money, and will not count toward your degree credits. Students can reach college readiness standards by meeting or exceeding specific scores on either the SAT, ACT, or TSI Assessment. A combination of test results may also be used to show college readiness.

#### WHERE DO I TAKE THE TSI TEST?

• Testing will occur in the College & Career Center, room 133 starting promptly at 9:00AM or 1:30PM. The test is untimed. For more details, contact Mrs. Mason in room 133.
