Prom Guidelines:

- Prom is for Anderson Seniors. Seniors are allowed to bring one guest. If you are bringing a guest that does not attend Anderson, they will need to fill out an application form. Electronic forms are available. Printed forms can also be obtained from Mrs. Bowen in Room 317 or from the box in the front office. Forms are due to Mrs. Bowen when you purchase a ticket.
- Students must be cleared of school obligations to purchase a ticket. You can email rosa.bowen@austinisd.org to check your obligations beginning early February.
- Tickets can be purchased in **Room 317 during lunch:**
 - March 21 and 22 (\$50)
 - March 27 and 28 (\$60)
 - April 11 - 12 (\$70)

No tickets will be sold at the door. To purchase a ticket, you must bring your ID. If you are bringing a guest **that does not attend Anderson**, you can purchase two tickets as long as you have submitted an approved guest application. Seniors who are bringing an underclassman guest who attends Anderson, must bring that guest with them when purchasing a ticket. Every student must present an ID.

- No arrivals after 10 pm.
- Once student(s) leaves Prom, student(s) will not be able to return.
- **Party buses are prohibited.**
- There will be a coat check which is sponsored by the junior class. Price is \$5. No bags of any type are allowed at the event.
- Dress code: Attendees who are wearing a suit should wear a suit with dress pants and a dress shirt, or a tuxedo. Students who choose to wear a dress should wear a dress that is no shorter than mid-thigh with an appropriate neckline, and shoes in good, clean condition. 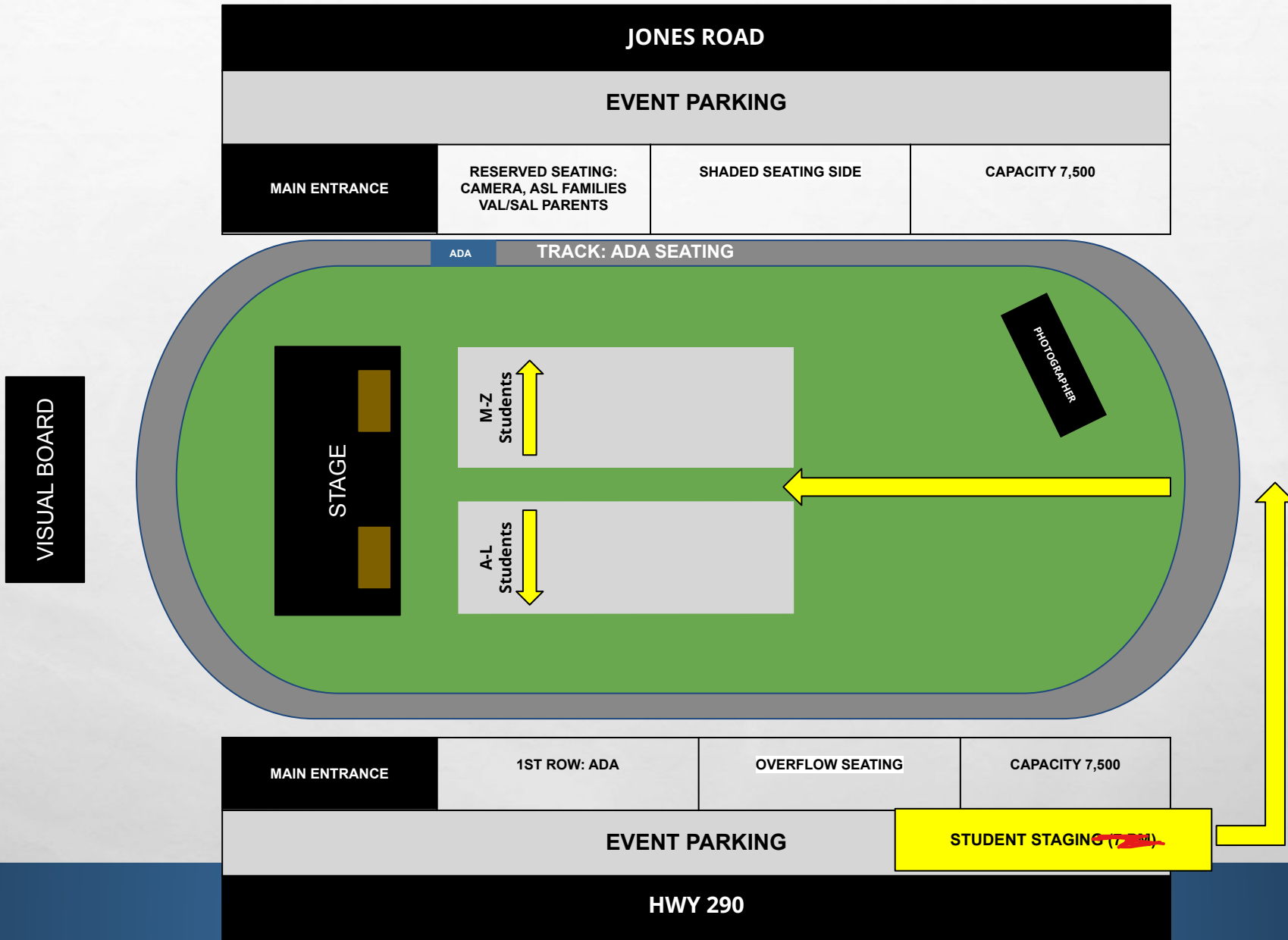
